Steroid Injections (with or without Ultrasound Guidance)

- · Head: occipital blocks
- Shoulder: rotator cuff, shoulder joint, biceps tendon, AC joint
- Elbow: elbow joint, lateral or medial epicondylitis (a.k.a. "tennis elbow", "golfer's elbow")
- Wrist: carpal tunnel, de quervain's tenosynovitis, small joints of wrist
- Fingers: CMC joint, trigger finger(s), other small joints
- · Hips: greater trochanter, hip joint
- · SI joint
- · Knees: knee joint, pes anserine bursa
- · Ankle: ankle joint
- · Foot/toes: MTP joint, small joints of feet
- · Trigger point injections
