Overview

A Family Medicine Physician Assistant (PA) works closely with physicians and other healthcare professionals to provide comprehensive primary care to patients of all ages. PAs in family medicine are integral members of the healthcare team, diagnosing and treating various medical conditions, providing preventative care, and managing ongoing chronic health conditions in an outpatient setting.

Key Responsibilities:

Clinical Responsibilities:

- Take comprehensive medical histories, perform physical examinations, and evaluate patients' medical conditions.
- Develop differential diagnoses and create treatment plans for common illnesses, injuries, and health concerns in family medicine.
- Counsel patients and families about their medical conditions, treatment options, preventive care, and lifestyle modifications.
- Perform minor procedures, such as suturing, joint injections, and wound care, depending on training and scope of practice.
- Provide preventive care services, including screenings, immunizations, and health education focused on nutrition, exercise, smoking cessation, and stress management.
- Monitor and manage chronic conditions such as diabetes, hypertension, asthma, and heart disease.
- Evaluate patient progress and adjust treatment plans as necessary, ensuring continuity of care.
- Provide remote telehealth services for same day acute health issues via home office at minimum of once every two weeks.

Documentation Responsibilities:

• Timely and accurately document patient histories, examinations, diagnostic tests, treatment plans, and progress notes in Electronic Health Records (EHR): EHR systems.

- Work collaboratively with physicians, nurses, medical assistants, and other healthcare providers to deliver comprehensive primary care services.
- Refer patients to specialists or other healthcare providers as needed for further evaluation or treatment.
- Write prescriptions, order laboratory tests, imaging studies, and other diagnostic procedures within the PA's scope of practice.

Team Collaboration & Continuing Education:

- Work within a collaborative team to ensure comprehensive patient care and a positive healthcare experience.
- Participate in continuing medical education (CME) to stay up to date with the latest clinical practices, medical advancements, and evidence-based guidelines in family medicine.
- Assist in training or mentoring medical students, residents, and other healthcare providers as needed.

- Master's degree in physician assistant studies from an accredited program.
- Current and active state licensure as a Physician Assistant (PA).
- Board Certification by the National Commission on Certification of Physician Assistants (NCCPA) or equivalent certification.
- CPR/BLS Certification required; ACLS preferred.

- Previous experience in family medicine or primary care preferred but not required.
- Experience with electronic health records (EHR) systems.
- Strong clinical and diagnostic skills with the ability to work independently and within a team setting.
- HIPPA regulations and PHI (Patient Health Insurance) compliance.

- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills with the ability to build rapport with patients and their families.
- Strong clinical judgment, attention to detail, and the ability to make informed decisions.
