Patient Responsibility	<ul> <li>Contact your Insurance Company to verify coverage and benefits. If prior authorization is required prior to procedure, contact your primary care clinic for a referral to be submitted to insurance.</li> <li>If you feel you need sedation, a driver is required on the day of the procedure</li> <li>If you need to cancel or change your appointment, please call Lakeview Clinic at 952-442-5755.</li> <li>Purchase 2 non-prescription Fleet Enemas from your pharmacy</li> </ul>
7 days prior to Procedure	<ul> <li>Stop taking NSAIDS (Aspirin, Ibuprofen, etc) Tylenol is ok</li> <li>Stop taking Plavix (Clopidogrel)</li> <li>Stop GLP-1 medications: Dulaglutide (Trulicity), Exenatide (Byetta, Bydureon), Liraglutide (Victoza), Lixisenatide (Adlyxin), or Semaglutide (Ozempic, Rybelsus, Wegovy) Check with your primary care provider or Endocrinologist before temporarily stopping these medications</li> </ul>
5 days prior to Procedure	<ul> <li>Stop taking Coumadin (Warfarin)</li> <li>Make sure that you have picked up your two (2) non-prescription Fleet Enemas from your pharmacy</li> </ul>

## 2 – 3 days prior to Procedure

Xarelto (Rivaroxaban), Pradaxa (Dabigatran Etexilate) and Eliquis: It is recommended to stop taking these medications two days prior to your procedure. If you have chronic kidney disease these medications should be stopped three days prior to your procedure. If your primary care provider DOES NOT want you to stop taking these medications, please have your primary care provider contact the provider doing the procedure

## 1 (one) day prior to Procedure

- You may eat normally
- NO alcoholic beverages

## Day of your Procedure

- **Do not** eat 8 hours prior to your procedure
- Continue to drink clear liquids
- You may take your medications
- 2 hours prior to check-in time Perform 1st Enema
- 1 hour prior to check-in time Perform 2<sup>nd</sup> Enema
- Stool should be yellow/clear absent of sediment

## Day of your Procedure

- If using sedation, **DO NOT** smoke, chew tobacco, use e-cigarettes, THC, marijuana or illicit drugs
- If you feel you need sedation, a driver is required. If you request sedation and do not have a driver, you will be given the option to proceed without sedation or reschedule. Driver must come inside and pick you up within 2 hours of the procedure.
- If you have sedation, you will need to **stop** drinking clear liquids 2 hours prior to procedure
- Bring all prescription medications and supplements with or bring a complete list with dosing and instructions
- Wear loose fitting clothing
- **Do not** wear perfume or cologne
- Bring photo ID and Insurance card(s)
